**ORDINANCE NO. 12-1820**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PACIFIC, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON,  
ESTABLISHING AND AUTHORIZING A TRAFFIC SAFETY SCHOOL TO BE ADMINISTERED IN CONJUNCTION  
WITH THE PACIFIC POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THE PACIFIC MUNICIPAL COURT. UNDER THE  
PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 46.83 OF THE REVISED CODE OF WASHINGTON**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council makes the following findings; and

**WHEREAS**, the Pacific Police Department enforces the traffic laws within the city limits; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Pacific recognizes the importance of traffic safety for the health, safety and welfare of its citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, a Traffic Safety School can provide the instruction, education and information for the proper, lawful and safe operation of motor vehicles.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PACIFIC, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON,  
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Establish.** The City Council finds that the establishment of a Traffic Safety School is in the best interest of its citizens in accordance with agreements between the City of Pacific Police Department and City of Pacific Municipal Court, as to the financing, organization and operation thereof and as regulated under the provisions of R.C.W. 46.83.010 of the laws of the State of Washington.

**Section 2. Purpose.** The City Council finds that the purpose of a Traffic Safety School is to provide instruction, education and information to all participants in the proper, lawful and safe operation of motor vehicles, including but not limited to rules of the road, and any and all relevant vehicle related City ordinances and/or codes, and the limitations of persons, vehicles, and bicycles and roads, streets, and highways under varying conditions and circumstances.


**Section 3. Fee.** The Pacific Police Department shall charge a fee to all Traffic School participants in an effort at assisting in the reimbursement of some or all costs associated with the administration of the Traffic Safety School. The fee shall be set at an amount established or amended by the City Council. Fee payments by all Traffic Safety School participants shall be remitted to City Hall in accordance with the procedures established in conjunction with the Pacific Police Department and the City of Pacific. Section 4. Severability. Each and every provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable. If any provision of this Ordinance should be deemed to be unconstitutional or otherwise contrary to the law by a Court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections so long as the intent of the Ordinance can be fulfilled without the illegal section.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five days after the date of publication.
