ORDINANCE No. 12 - 1825**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PACIFIC, WASHINGTON, AMENDING PACIFIC
MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.80.010 REGARDING PAYMENT OF CLAIMS OR
OBLIGATIONS**

WHEREAS, the City of Pacific does not currently have staff in all of the positions authorized to sign City checks; and

WHEREAS, the City Treasurer is serving in place of a Finance Director

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PACIFIC, WASHINGTON, DO
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Pacific Municipal Code section 3.80.010 is amended as follows:


Payment of claims or obligations of the City shall be by check. The qualified public depository, where on such checks are to be drawn, shall be Columbia Bank. The City officers authorized to sign checks shall be the Mayor, Mayor Pro tempore, City Clerk, Finance Director and Treasurer. Checks shall be signed by any two of the foregoing authorized signatories.

Section 3. Severability. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this Ordinance be pre-empted by state or federal law or regulation, such decision or preemption shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance or its application.


Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force effective immediately upon passage and signing.
