ORDINANCE NO. 12-1829

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PACIFIC, WASHINGTON AMENDING PACIFIC MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 20.06 RELATING TO THE DEFINITION OF BUY BACK RECYCLING CENTER

WHEREAS it would be in the interest of efficiency and effectiveness for the City of Pacific to make certain amendments to Pacific Municipal Code (PMC) Subsection 20.06.080 (G),

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF PACIFIC, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS

(repealed language is noted by strike through and new language is in bold)

Section 1. PMC 20.06.080 (G) "Commercial Use Categories" is amended as follows:

20.06.080 Commercial use category.


G. Buy-Back Recycling Center. "Buy-back recycling center" use type refers to ~~any small-scale~~ **a** business without industrial activity which collects, receives, or buys recyclable materials from household, commercial, or industrial sources for the purpose of sorting, grading, or packaging, **without changing the essential form or nature of** recyclables for subsequent shipment and marketing (also see the industrial use category for recycling processor use type).

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five days after the date of publication.
