3. AGENDA ITEMS

A. Ordinance No. 12-1828, Amending Pacific Municipal Code Chapters 20.04; 20.06 and 20.60 Relating To The Regulation Of Recycling Processors -

Councilmember Steiger made a motion to refer them these two Ordinances back to a committee for site visits then report back to the Planning Commission and have the Planning Commission report back to Council; Councilmember Hulse second;

Council Discussion: Councilmember Steiger would like three members from Council who used to be on the Planning Commission; Councilmember Jones, Councilmember Putnam and Councilmember Guier and have them tour facilities together and report t back to the Planning Commission. Councilmember Hulse states there is not enough information to make a decision at this time. Ken Luce states this may not be appropriate action for Council to meet with the Planning Commission; it is best to appoint a committee of three and have the committee review their findings and present their recommendations to Council. Howard Gustafson has been on the Planning Commission for the last 12 years and is familiar with all the problems with recycling. Howard states that the Planning Commission reviewed the recycling Ordinances and felt that it needed to be referred back to Council. Howard further states that the Planning Commission only studies information and does not physically review sites and does not go out and inspect. Councilmember Putnam is concern on the distinction between level one and two processors. The two levels are discussed. Councilmember Hulse made a motion to amend the motion that Ordinance 12-1828 and Ordinance 12-1829 be referred to a special Council committee consisting of Councilmember Jones, Councilmember Putnam and Councilmember Guier and report back to Council; Councilmember Steiger second;
