PRESS RELEASE

June 17, 2015 – The City of Pacific Public Works Department is announcing that a segment of Valentine Road will be closed at night for one week to allow for the installation of sewer main and laterals.

Valentine Road will be closed Monday, June 22 until Friday, June 26, 2015. The road closure is at night starting at approximately 7:00 p.m until 5:00 a.m each day. The closure will take place between Roy and County Line Roads. The road is scheduled to be reopen to night traffic beginning Friday, June 26, 2015.

Day time construction work will continue with traffic control devices and flaggers in use. Motorist can continue to expect normal daytime traffic delays

This work is part of the \$18 million 136th/Valentine Corridor Improvement Project which is a joint project between the City of Pacific and Sumner. Improvements include a new center turn lane, new signal at 24th Street, revised signal at Stewart Road, sidewalks, street lighting, a shared-use path, stormwater conveyance, channelization, landscaping and water and sewer utility work.

Traffic signage will be in place to detour motorists around the work zone. Motorists are urged to use caution and to avoid the area if possible.

NOTE: Fire and Police vehicles will be able to pass through closure if necessary.
